Meeting 4: Activism

Note: PLM will mail the materials for this meeting.

Purpose: To spread the pro-life message and strengthen the relationships in your group.

Open the Meeting: (5 min.)

Welcome & Meeting Purpose (2 min.)

Role Count: (1 min.)

• sign up sheet or have secretary take note

Announcements: (2 min.)

- Next meeting will be a (choose one) Discussion/Activism/Educational meeting. Note: Remind them if they need to read/watch anything prior to the next meeting.
- Update about upcoming events, tabling, outreach opportunities, etc.

Debrief from Outreach, if applicable (10-15 minutes)

Use the Debrief Guide (on our website, under outreach) to debrief from a recent outreach. This only needs to be done once for each outreach. The purpose of debriefing is to share experiences and learn from mistakes and successes.

Activism: (25 min.)

Dropcard Activism

- Pair people up in groups of two and distribute the dropcards provided by PLM.
- Have each pair shout out a different building that they will scatter the dropcards in. Try to reach far & wide on campus, so that students all over are exposed to the pro-life message!
- Optional: Make it a challenge! See which group can hit the most buildings and distribute the most cards before everyone reunites at the end of the night.

Note: We highly encourage that your groups reunites after splitting up for activism. It will help you to debrief and build relationships within your group.

Socialize & Close the Meeting:

- Thank you for coming! (Make them feel valued)
- Next Meeting will be a (choose one) Activism/Discussion/Educational meeting (where and when).
- Reminder of Club Announcements.

Note: We recommend using this time for social connection. Bond with your members over late night appetizers, bowling, ice cream, a study session, etc. Get creative - but focus on strengthening friendships!
